Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

THEME: Our lives are transformed when we allow the Spirit to lead us to Jesus, the Truth of the Father's love.

WORD : Prv 8:22-31 ~ Ps 8:4-5,6-7,8-9
Rom 5:1-5 ~ Jn 16:12-15

ORDER: *"... boast in hope of the glory of God... through the holy Spirit that has been given to us."* (Rom 5:2,5)

REFLECTION:

The fundamental teaching of our Catholic faith reveals to us that there is one God and that there are three Divine Persons in one God - the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. That is the mystery of the Most Holy Trinity. No one can fully understand this dogma but in full faith we believe this as true and accept it. We profess this belief when we recite the Creed: "consubstantial with the Father" and "...the Holy Spirit...who proceeds from the Father and the Son."

In the First Reading, the Wisdom of God speaks about being present when God planned and created the universe. This connotes that there was another Being that concurred with God's work, and that therefore, there is more than one Person in God. God the Father created us and called us to faith.

Jesus Christ, the Son, became man, and in obedience to the Father's will, died for our sins to redeem us, and His redemptive sacrifice made us children of God. After Christ's ascension, the Holy Spirit came upon us and became our Teacher, our Sanctifier and made us His temple. Each Person in the Holy Trinity participated in the work of incarnation, redemption, and sanctification. In the Holy Trinity, there is perfect love and harmony.

In the Gospel reading, Jesus tells His disciples of the coming of *"the Spirit of truth, he will guide you to all truth"* (John 16:13). Jesus' mission on earth was completed and He had to depart from His physical presence here. He had lived among men, and for the last three years of His life, He imparted His teachings to those who followed Him. He wanted His teachings to truly take root in the hearts and minds of all and apply them in their daily lives.

In God's perfect plan, the Holy Spirit came into our hearts to continue the work that Christ started. The Holy Spirit is the first "gift" - the gift of love that guides us along the path of holiness and committed discipleship. He instills in us the spirit of understanding so that we may apply God's Word in our lives. He leads us to Jesus and His grace, and the charity of the Father and the Truth of His unconditional love for us.

When we listen attentively to and reflect on God's Word, He will touch our hearts so that His message would be able to guide us on our life's journey. We will be able to open ourselves to the leadings of the Holy Spirit Who wants us to fully grasp God's Word and follow it. We will realize that the Most Holy Trinity is perfect love, always there for us in the midst of our struggles and afflictions. The love and mercy of the Father is manifested in His plan of salvation by the passion and death of Jesus Christ. The Holy Spirit guides us to the truth of the love of God and inspires us to follow Christ.

When we open our hearts to His perfect love, we experience authentic transformation that will make our spiritual journey overflow with blessings as our lives and relationships will be in perfect harmony. Just as the love of God reaches out to others and to the world, we too will be able to fill the hearts of men with God's love as we reach out to the ends of the earth through our deeds and prayers. As we accept God's mandate to enter into a deeper relationship with Him, we are called to follow His examples of self-sacrificing generosity to others, →→
